“Tick-Safe Zones,” should be created for homes, parks, fields and recreational areas. Increasing exposure to sun and air by removing leaf litter and tall grass will reduce the number of ticks. Laying down wood chips where lawns and recreational areas reside can create a dry barrier and reduce the tick population.

## **TICK SOLUTIONS: HOW DO I REDUCE THE POPULATION ON MY PROPERTY?**

Deer ticks require a complicated two year lifecycle.

- Keep grass mowed and well groomed
- Remove yard clippings (move grass piles, brush)
- Create raised flower beds or ornamental plantings in containers
- Discourage deer and rodent activity

### **HOW DO I PROTECT MYSELF FROM TICKS?**

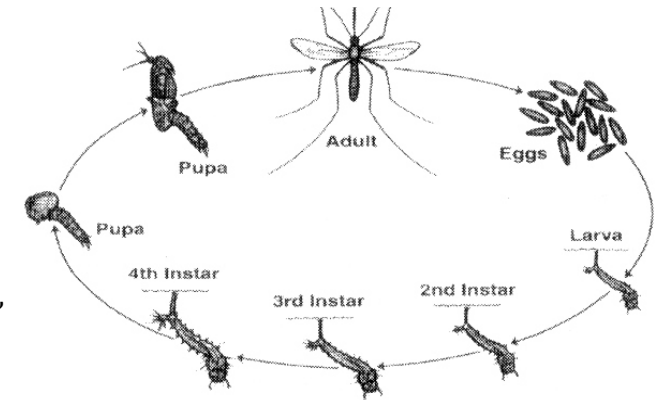
- Wearing light colored clothing makes spotting a tick easier
- Pants should be tucked into socks
- Shirts should be tucked into pant waistband
- When out walking/hiking, stay on the path
- Use approved insect repellent when outdoors
- Avoid areas known to have dense tick population
- Inspect your body immediately upon return
- Speak to your veterinarian on ways to protect your pets
- Relocate children's play areas away from the woodland edge
